The work of the forum is aimed at implementing the Message of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan K.K. Tokayev to the people of Kazakhstan dated September 01, 2023 "The Economic course of a Fair Kazakhstan" and the position of the second **National Kurultai** "Adilette Kazakhstan – Adal Azamat".

The forum is dedicated to the 10th anniversary of the Faculty of History, which reopened in 2013 within the walls of L.N. Gumilev Eurasian National University.

The purpose of the forum is to consider the continuity of the history of the peoples of Central Asia, the analysis of scientific positions, the study of cultural values and the exchange of experience.

The articles submitted to the collection must be designed in accordance with the following requirements:

1. The registration form and the text of the report (in accordance with the topic of the forum and no more than 7 pages in length) must necessarily be typed in the MS Word text editor, the file with the report must be named by the author's surname.

2. Page format – A4, font – Times New Roman, size – 12, upper and lower borders – 2 sm, right border - 1 sm, left border - 3 sm, line spacing – one, indent: 1.25.

3. The title of the report is written at the beginning: in CAPITAL letters (**bold**) in the middle of the line.

4. Under the title of the report in the center, the surname, initials of the author, academic degree, academic title (if any) are written in lowercase letters (**bold**).

5. The next line indicates the place of work, the position of the author.

6. The text of the report is placed at one interval.

7. The list of references and data is located at the end of the report and is compiled in the order of meetings in the text. References are made in square brackets in the form of a number indicating the source page according to the list [6, p. 2].
